▪ MEDICAL BATTALION

▪ 6 TASKS OF MED BN – **2RIP MD**

- **2RIP** = 2nd Echelon care – Regulating – Intelligence – Preventive Med
- **MD** = Mass casualties – Decontamination

○ H&S COMPANY

▪ Mission = **C&C A/S** to Battalion

• 4 TASKS – **LAMP**

- Limited Medevac – Admin – Medical Data – Personnel to HQ

○ ALPHA & BRAVO SURGICAL COMPANY

▪ Mission = Provide **GENERAL** medical and surgical support to **MEF**

▪ Each company has 4 Surgical Platoons

- Each Surgical Platoon has One FRSS, STPs, X-Ray, Lab, Ward, En-route Care System (1 Nurse & FMF), and Ambulance Section (2 vehicles)

▪ 6 TASKS OF SURG CO — **REC MMM**

- **REC** = Receive casualties | Evac Casualties | Coordinate Medical Evac for landing forces
- **MMM** = Medical Facilities for US | Medical Facilities supported forces | Medical Personnel to others

FRSS:

Forward Resuscitative Surgery System: Free standing modular for quick surgery capabilities in forward combat 24hrs for a minimum of 48hrs without resupply. FRSS uses 2 Surgeons, 1 Anesthesiologist, 1 Critical Care Nurse, 1 IDC, 1 Field Med Tech, and 2 OR Techs for 18 salvage surgeries, or 20 trauma resuscitations over 48 hours.

BAS- Battalion Aid Station | **RAS**- Regimental Aid Station | **GAS**- Group Aid Station | **MTF**- Military Treatment Facility | **STP** Shock Trauma Platoon | **HSS**- Health Services Support | **MAP**- Medical Augmentation Program | **BDC**- Blood Donor Center | **CRTS**- Casualty Receiving and Treatment Center | **FMC**- Field Medical Card | **TMIP**- Theater Medical Information Program

ECHELONS OF CARE:

- Level I Combat Corpsman – Initial care/CLS and at BAS or STP
- Level II FRSS & CRTS
- Level III Fleet Hospitals/TAHs/Army CSH – Initial Resuscitative Surgical Care
- Level IV Definitive Care @ OCONUS MTFs (Germany)
- Level V Rehabilitative care – CONUS Hospitals (Walter Reed)

137 – Engineering Service Battalion (7 blocks – HE BEE BE)

▪ ENGINEERING SERVICE BATTALION

- Mission = Provide **GENERAL** engineering support of an expeditionary nature to the MAGTF.
- 15 TASKS OF ESB — **BLEED DRAW FUCEM**
 - **BLEED** = Bridging – Laundry – EOD - Encampments – Demolition
 - **DRAW** = Deception - Recon - Airfields – Water Purification
 - **FUCEM** = Fuel – Utilities – Counter Mobility – **Counter** Mobility Ops – Enhancement (survivability) – **Mobility** Enhancements

- HQ COMPANY:
 - Mission = **C&C A/S** to the **MEF**
- ENGINEERING SUPPORT COMPANY:
 - Mission = Provide **DIRECT** maintenance to Engineer CO's equipment
- ENGINEERING COMPANY (x2):
 - Mission = Provide **GENERAL** engineering support (HE) for the **MEF**
- BRIDGE COMPANY:
 - Mission = Provide **GENERAL** and **tactical** bridges for the **MEF**
- BULK FUEL COMPANY:
 - Mission = Provide **GENERAL** support of bulk fuel up to the ACE for the **MEF**
- EOD COMPANY:
 - Mission = Provide EOD support for things that go boom

NOTES:

138 – Dental Battalion (4 blocks - HDDD)

- DENTAL BATTALION
 - Mission = Provide **GENERAL** dental support to the MEF
 - 4 TASKS OF THE DENTAL BN – **PCPS**
 - P – Provide Comprehensive Dental
 - C – Coordinate that Dental Care
 - P – Provide Detachments in Support
 - S – Supervise how they are doing

- H&S COMPANY
 - Mission = C&C A/S
- DENTAL COMPANY (x3)
 - Mission = Provide **GENERAL** dental support to MEF by (1) maintaining readiness and (2) comprehensive coverage.

*Hint: Total Blocks = 7564 | 3457 | 4 (memorize those numbers, draw the blocks, and sketch out each Regiment/Battalion as you will be asked the make-up of each on the board). If you can sketch out each Regiment/Battalion and their makeup, you'll then be able to apply what is general, direct, or both. And then memorize what force they support (think real world what the unit does). Write this out over and over until you have it down to a science.
